



The Anti-Fascist Action group says it will take any steps necessary to stop the concert — organised by the shadowy group Blood and Honour. Mike Stone, of AFA said: "As far as we are concerned Blood and Honour has only one agenda — the terrorism of anyone opposed to them. We are prepared to meet like with like."

But those who did were met by up to 500 Leftwingers from the Anti-Fascist Action group, chanting: "Nazi scum off our streets."

As the fascists huddled together for safety behind police lines, one black-shirted skinhead had a heart attack and was taken away in an ambulance.



STOP STRIP SEARCHES

There was a good turnout at a meeting organised to highlight the continuing injustice of the strip search. The meeting was part of a tour which also took in Glasgow and Manchester and focused on the treatment given to female Republican prisoners in Maghdaberry, N. Ireland.

Those attending also heard a speaker from the James Connolly Society and a member of Glasgow A.F.A. who spoke on the links between loyalists and fascists in Scotland.

The meeting on Thursday 22 October at the Unemployed Workers Centre in Broughton St had itself been threatened by loyalists, and activists from Edinburgh A.F.A. turned out to give support. The meeting went without incident.

THE BATTLE OF WATERLOO

On Saturday September 12, the neonazi music organisation Blood & Honour planned to hold a gig in London headlined by fascist rock band Skrewdriver. However, they made the mistake of publicising the re-direction point and fascists turning up at Waterloo Station were met by a crowd of between 1000 and 1500 anti-fascists. As a result, instead of a hoped for 2000 at the gig, only 200 to 300 managed to make it.

We reprint some of the text from A.F.A.'s press release given the day after the event:

"At Waterloo it was a tactical battle between us and the far right; us and the police. Yesterday we won. Once the police were forced to close the station through weight of numbers we knew we were in control.

The battle for Waterloo was a watershed in the struggle between the forces of the left and the right throughout Europe. The media appears to be obsessed with the far right, but the groups behind Anti Fascist Action are also ideologically driven, its a battle for control of the streets. Militant anti-fascism is a means to an end. We too have long term objectives.

The tactics favoured by the Anti-Nazi League and other liberal anti-racist groups have been eclipsed by yesterdays victory. Unlike them we dont believe in token demonstrations or in calling for state bans.

At one point yesterday riot police and fascists actually fought side by side in a pitched battle with anti fascists under the railway bridge, next to the festival hall. Furious phone calls from entrapped fascists to the concert organisers who had remained in Victoria, asking them to provide rescue or venue details, apparently went unheeded. It should be significant to both the fascists and anti fascists that at this crucial juncture, the fascists' leadership is prepared to abandon their own supporters. There are lessons to be learned for the working class youth on both sides.

If the anti fascist movement in Europe had implemented a policy of No Platform for Fascists with the same commitment as we did yesterday, Rostock would still be just a little town in Germany."

It should be noted that instead of joinng A.F.A. in confronting the fascists at Waterloo, the Anti-Nazi League chose to rold a demo in Croydon, miles away rom where ordinary people were putting words into action. Fascism will not be Below: Another battered bastard! Waterloo 12/10/92

WHAT IS AFA?

AFA is a non sectarian DEMOCRATIC organisation dedicated to confronting fascism wherever it rears its ugly head. We are not controlled by or are a part of any political party. AFA consists of peofrom many political persuasions.

HOW DOES AFA OPERATE?

WHAT ABOUT OTHER GROUPS ?

Those left wing groups who denounce other anti-fascists for their militancy or who claim to be non-violent while trying to claim successful militant actions as their own doing are dangerous diversions and should be left well alone.

CLASS ?

Fascism is a threat to all working class people and should be fought from a

working class perspective. When fascists have been in power the first victims have always been the working class. Their politics and beliefs are not just racist they are anti-democratic and anti-working class. If their meetings are accepted and allowed to go ahead they gain strength and if they gain

enough strength then we can look forward to a society where the weak and disabled are culled, where leftwing and liberal opinions of any sort will be stamped on, where the welfare state and health service are destroyed and where one man (Adolf Hitler?) controls a military style dictatorship with thick bastards as his foot soldiers.
