WHAT SUPPORTING THE BNP MEANS FOR YOU

The BNP tell you they are for the 'white race' and against Blacks, Jews etc., and that once Britain has been 'ethnically cleansed', life will be sweet for all white people. But what will that mean for the average, white working class person living in the BNP's new order? You probably know already that the BNP attack Black, Jewish, Irish and Gay people. What you should know is (even if you're not in one of the above groups), once you've elected them, once they've gained power, if you're working class, you're next.

In fact, this process has started already. BNP activists have already extended their franchise of violence a little wider. Those the fascists perceive as "reds" are clearly being targeted in order to supplement the traditional diet of fascist bigotry, but this is not the whole story. Anti-Fascist Action has consistently said that, once the fascists attain a certain level of momentum, they'll target the entire working class.

The BNP tell you, that a vote for them is a 'vote for real change'. This is a lie. You vote BNP, you vote Ultra Conservative.

● HOUSING

Under this Conservative government, £328,000,000,000 has been raised by the sale of council houses. At the same time, subsidies to local councils for repairs and new housing have been systematically cut year by year. This policy has condemned hundreds of thousands of working class families, white and black, to live in run down, or temporary accommodation.

The BNP's solution? "Property owners, should be given [financial] incentives to let... council housing subsidies should be eliminated."

● UNEMPLOYMENT

The Conservatives are dismantling the Welfare State. The BNP would like to see this process accelerate. While Major "wonders about requiring activity in return for unemployment benefit": the BNP have no hesitation. The unemployed should be made to work for their dole.

"Social Services should not be regarded as an absolute right - social welfare should be earned"

● LAW AND ORDER

Next to Turkey, which is run by a military dictatorship, Britain, under the Conservatives has the highest prison population in Europe. Nevertheless the BNP blame the government for "softness, liberalism and excessive tolerance".

The BNP campaign for "sentences to be made longer; corporal punishment to be made available, and the death penalty to be restored" (despite the fact that implementation of this would seriously reduce the BNP's own membership!).

● DEMOCRACY

Since 1979 the Conservative principle agenda has been 'the right of management to manage'. The application of this slogan has seen the average income of top company directors rise to £450,000 a year; directly at the expense of 12 million working people now living beneath the poverty line. The BNP make no comment on this state of affairs: because for them it is the natural order of things. For all fascists, any form of democracy represents an intolerable interference by working people in economic affairs. They would like to see 'managements right to manage' carried over from the economic sphere to the political sphere.

The Conservatives model for local government, (unelected, unaccountable quangos) is the BNP's model for national government. Unaccountable government, is what they mean by "revolutionary reform". In brief dictatorship. And the dictatorship would be run by, and in the interests of...? "...a picked number of human beings...not troubled by humanitarian feelings... who are convinced they have the right as being the superior race...the capitalists have worked their way to the top, through their capacity on the basis of this selection, which again only proves them as the higher race, they have the right to lead..."

Like German dictator Adolf Hitler (quoted above), the BNP's inspiration, when the far-right speak of racism, they refer to their belief in the natural superiority between races, but also, and even more decisively, within races. As the evidence shows, though many of the supporters of the BNP are poor, they are also the enemies of the poor.
