WHY A.F.A. IN EDINBURGH?

The BNP and other fascists are active in and around Lothian - racial attacks, graffiti, stickers and even paper selling. This is a situation that we are not prepared to tolerate.

Anti - fascist leaflets, stickers, gigs are all very well but without actually confronting the fascists physically then all propoganda is useless. We must stop simply responding to whatever the BNP do but must start taking the fight to them. We believe that our streets, schemes and workplaces should be permanently free from fascist scum spreading their hate and any attempt to meet, march or to sell papers must be physically stopped.

AREN'T THERE ENOUGH ANTI-RACIST/FASCIST GROUPS ALREADY?

Yes, but unfortunately most of them are set up as recruitment fronts for political parties. The A.N.L. was set up by the SWP only months after they had declared that "nazis wern't a problem". Others like Youth against Racism and Workers against Racism were set up by Militant and the R.C.P.

A.F.A. is a non sectarian, democratic organisation that has been fighting fascism for many years, we co-operate with other genuine, local campaigns.

Other groups seem content to sell papers and chant slogans but do nothing about the problem. When we say 'no platform for fascists', we mean it.
